NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS

Since 2007, MN Rules Chapter 7080 has required an assessment of every septic tank every three years, at minimum. This assessment includes the measurement or removal of scum and sludge accumulations as well as a determination of whether the sewage tank leaks.

In keeping with State and County regulations, Linwood Township is now required to monitor septic systems to assure they are pumped or inspected every three years

Please contact a certified/licensed professional to proceed with the required inspection or pumping. The licensed professional will send your report to the Township.
